

RESOLUTION NO. 1989- 40

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MARSHALL FORD, INC. FOR
THE FURNISHING OF SEVEN (7) TRANSIT POLICE VEHICLES
(EST. \$132,193.50 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0078)**

WHEREAS, the bid of Marshall Ford, Inc. for the furnishing of Seven (7) Transit Police Vehicles was received on the 17th day of March, 1989, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of One Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars & 50/100 (\$132,193.50); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Marshall Ford, Inc. to be lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Marshall Ford, Inc. be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Marshall Ford, Inc. for the furnishing of Seven (7) Transit Police Vehicles.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-0078 in an estimated amount not to exceed One Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Three & 50/100 (\$132,193.50).

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
