

RESOLUTION NO. 1989- 79

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH METRO TRANSPORTATION & HEALTH RESOURCES FOR THE FURNISHING OF SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION FOR THE ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR WITH A MONTH-TO-MONTH OPTION FOR A SECOND YEAR (EST. \$1,374,871.68 - GENERAL FUND) PARATRANSIT DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the bid of Metro Transportation & Health Resources for the furnishing of Special Transportation for the Elderly and Handicapped was received on the 15th day of June, 1989, for the price set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of One Million Three Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-One & 68/100 (\$1,374,871.68); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Metro Transportation & Health Resources to be a reasonably priced bid from a sole responsive and responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Metro Transportation & Health Resources be and the same is hereby accepted as a reasonably priced bid from a sole responsive and responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Metro Transportation & Health Resources for the furnishing of Special Transportation for the Elderly and Handicapped for a period of one (1) year with a month-to-month option for a second year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Paratransit Department Budget) in an estimated amount for the base contract period and option not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-One & 68/100 (\$1,374,871.68) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
