AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH EAGLE INTERNATIONAL TRUCK SALES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1) MAINTENANCE VAN (EST. \$83,216.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0078) POWER DEPARTMENT
