

RESOLUTION NO. 1989 - 120

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER/SECRETARY-TREASURER TO TERMINATE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO BUILDING AUTHORITY AND TOWER CITY PROPERTIES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PASSENGER ACCESSWAY BETWEEN TOWER CITY AND THE FRANK J. LAUSCHE STATE OFFICE BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority acting through Resolution No. 1982-254 authorized the execution of an agreement by and between the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, the Ohio Building Authority and Tower City Properties for the financing and construction of a passenger accessway between the Frank J. Lausche State Office Building and Tower City; and

WHEREAS, an agreement for this purpose was executed on October 15, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the parties to the original agreement have collectively agreed not to pursue the construction of this passenger accessway.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. The General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is authorized to execute a Termination Agreement with the Ohio Building Authority and Tower City Properties to abandon the construction of the passenger accessway;


Section 2. The \$1,280,000.00 in approved Federal funds for this project in Grant No. OH-03-0062 will be reprogrammed for other grant-eligible projects;

Section 3. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
