

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-130

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WOOSTER IRON & METAL
FOR THE SALE OF 37 NON-OPERABLE COACHES**

WHEREAS, Coaches No.'s 839, 849, 853, 857, 858, 859, 860, 868, 870, 871, 874, 875, 877, 878, 879, 883, 890, 893, 895, 896, 2143, 2556, 2587, 2648, 8006, 8009, 8012, 8019, 8028, 8037, 8047, 8093, 8104, 8109, 8113 and 8140 have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with the Authority's bus replacement policy or in accordance with the Board of Trustees previous Resolution 1986-141 authorizing the sale of American Motors General Coaches; and

WHEREAS, the bids of Nimco Shredding Co., Wooster Iron and Metal and Lee D. Smith were received on the 12th day of September, 1989.

WHEREAS, the bid of Wooster Iron and Metal for each of the 37 Non-Operable Coaches was deemed to be the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Wooster Iron and Metal for a total of Twenty-Two Thousand Ninety-One Dollars & 05/100 (\$22,091.05) for the purchase of Coach No's. 839, 849, 853, 857, 858, 859, 860, 868, 870, 871, 874, 875, 877, 878, 879, 883, 890, 893, 895, 896, 2143, 2556, 2587, 2648, 8006, 8009, 8012, 8019, 8028, 8037, 8047, 8093, 8104, 8109, 8113 and 8140 be and the same is hereby deemed as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wooster Iron and Metal for the sale of said property on such terms as are appropriate for the protection of the interest of the Authority.

Section 3. That the proceeds of said sales, Twenty-Two Thousand Ninety-One Dollars & 05/100 (\$22,091.05), be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
