

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COLEJON MECHANICAL CORPORATION FOR CLEANING SERVICES OF BUS PASSENGER SHELTERS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS (NOT TO EXCEED \$503,048.00 - GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the sole bid of Colejon Mechanical Corporation located at 13836 Union Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44120 for cleaning services of bus passenger shelters was received on September 25, 1989 for the prices set forth in said bid involving expenditures not to exceed Five Hundred Three Thousand Forty-Eight & 00/100 Dollars (\$503,048.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Colejon Mechanical Corporation for cleaning services of bus passenger shelters to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder for a reasonable price and recommends acceptance thereof by the board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Colejon Mechanical Corporation for the furnishing of cleaning services for bus passenger shelters be and the same is hereby accepted as a reasonable and responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter a contract with Colejon Mechanical Corporation for the furnishing of said services for a period of two (2) years.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Three Thousand Forty-Eight & 00/100 Dollars (\$503,048.00).

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
