

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-17

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MULTICRAFT, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF VINYL SHEETING/TAPE REFLECTIVE, AND NON-REFLECTIVE, FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING MARCH 1, 1990 THRU DECEMBER 31, 1990 (NOT TO EXCEED \$110,935.55 - GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Multicraft, Inc., located at 8601 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44106 for the furnishing of vinyl sheeting/tape, reflective and non-reflective, was received on the 5th of February 1990, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure not to exceed One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Five & 00/100 (\$110,935.00) Dollars;

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Multicraft, Inc. to be the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Multicraft, Inc. be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a requirements contract with Multicraft, Inc. for the furnishing of vinyl sheeting/tape, reflective and non-reflective, for the period beginning March 1, 1990 thru December 31, 1990.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Five & 00/100 (\$110,935.00) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
