AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PAT'S ACTION AUTO BODY & FRAME, INC FOR THE FURNISHING OF TOWING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR (NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 - GENERAL FUND) BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET
