

RESOLUTION 1990-53

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GLOBE GLASS & MIRROR CO.,
INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF TEMPERED GLASS FOR BUS
SHELTERS FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS (EST \$203,990.40
- GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the bid of Globe Glass & Mirror Co., Inc., located at 1880 W. Fullerton, Chicago, Illinois 60614, for the furnishing of Tempered Glass for bus shelters for a period of three (3) years was received on the 28th day of March, 1990 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Two Hundred Three Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety & 40/100 Dollars (\$203,990.40); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Globe Glass & Mirror Co., Inc., to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Globe Glass & Mirror Co., Inc., received March 28, 1990, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Globe Glass & Mirror Co., Inc., for the furnishing of Tempered Glass for bus shelters for a period of three (3) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) in an estimated amount not to exceed Two Hundred Three Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety & 40/100 Dollars (\$203,990.40).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years; compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements; and all applicable laws relating to the contractual requirements of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
