

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-73

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BURKE-PARSONS-BOWLBY FOR THE FURNISHING OF RAILROAD TIMBER TIES AND SPIKES AS REQUIRED FOR THE PERIOD ENDING MAY 31, 1991 (Est. \$87,250.00) - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0019

WHEREAS, the bid of Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation located at P. O. Box 231, Ripley, West Virginia 25271 for the furnishing of railroad timber ties and spikes was received on the 16th of April, 1990, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of eighty-seven thousand two hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$87,250.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation to be the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Burke-Parsons-Bowlby Corporation for the furnishing of railroad ties and spikes for the period ending May 31, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Burke-Parson-Bowlby Corporation for the furnishing of railroad timber ties and spikes as required for a period of one (1) year, ending May 31, 1991.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Grant OH-90-0019 in an estimated amount not to exceed eighty-seven thousand two hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$87,250.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon; appropriations for future contract years; compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
