

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-117

**AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 89004 WITH
SENKIW & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A
SPECIFICATION FOR A PASSENGER INFORMATION SYSTEM FOR
THE GCRTA RAIL SYSTEM (EST \$69,835.00 - RTA CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT FUND)**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1989-48, adopted April 18, 1989 authorized a contract with Senkiw & Associates, Inc. for the development of a specification for a Passenger Information System for GCRTA Rail System at a price of one hundred fifty-six thousand thirty-six & 00/100 (\$156,036.00) dollars; and

WHEREAS, additional architectural drawings and other technical coordinations with signage vendors and subcontractors resulted in scope, price, and schedule changes which are necessary to keep this project on schedule which is in the best interest of the Authority ; and

WHEREAS, it is mutually agreeable to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and to Senkiw and Associates to extend the contract completion date for a period of one (1) month to July 31, 1990; and

WHEREAS, an estimated price adjustment of sixty-nine thousand eight hundred thirty-five & 00/100 (\$69,835.00) dollars is required to complete and deliver the specification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and his is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Senkiw & Associates, Inc. estimated price adjustment of sixty-nine thousand eight hundred thirty-five & 00/10 (\$69,835.00) for a revised total estimated contract amount of two hundred twenty-five eight hundred seventy-one & 00/100 (\$225,871.00) dollars.

Section 2. That said contract amendment shall be payable from the RTA Capital Improvement Fund.


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

That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
