

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-163

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER WITH UNION SWITCH & SIGNAL, INC. FOR PROJECT 12A, BID PACKAGE C - CUT WINDERMERE, TO PROVIDE FLOOD EMERGENCY ROUTING, FOR AN INCREASE IN COST OF \$277,267.00 (CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0097)

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1988-179 authorized a contract with Union Switch and Signal, Inc. in the amount of fourteen million three hundred seventeen thousand three hundred thirty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$14,317,334.00), for providing cab signaling, CUT to Windermere;

WHEREAS, flooding in the tunnels at the East 55th Street light rail junction has been a persistent problem;

WHEREAS, a new emergency routing is necessary to avoid severe disruption of light rail service; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the work required to provide the emergency flood routing is estimated not to exceed two hundred seventy-seven thousand, two hundred sixty-seven & 00/100 (\$277,267.00).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to execute a change order to the contract between the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and Union Switch & Signal, Inc., to increase the contract by two hundred seventy-seven thousand two hundred sixty-seven & 00/100 dollars (\$277,267.00).

Section 2. That the contract as amended shall provide for a total expenditure not to exceed fourteen million five hundred ninety-four thousand, six hundred one & 00/100 dollars (\$14,594,601.00).

Section 3. That the said increase in expenditures shall be partially funded through Capital Grant OH-03-0097.

Section 4. That all other provisions of said contract shall remain unchanged.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon it's adoption.
