

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-164

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO INCREASE THE CONTRACTS RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY CONDITION CAUSED BY THE DIESEL FUEL SPILL AT THE HAYDEN GARAGE (WEBSTER ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES, \$100,000.00 AND GEORGE ALLEN CONSTRUCTION CO., \$400,000.00 - AUTHORITY SELF-INSURANCE FUND)

WHEREAS, on July 24, 1990, Resolution No. 1990-131 ratified an emergency declaration relating to property damage resulting from a diesel fuel leak at the Hayden Garage;

WHEREAS, Resolution 1990-131 authorized the General Manager to enter into contracts with George Allen Construction Co., for four hundred ten thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$410,000.00) and Webster Engineering Associates for one hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$100,000); and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed to control and contain movement of the contaminated product.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That a real and present emergency exists involving damage to structures and equipment resulting from the leakage of diesel fuel at the Hayden Garage.

Section 2. That the General Manager is authorized to increase the contract with George Allen Construction Co. for an estimated amount not to exceed \$400,000.00, and for Webster Engineering for an estimated amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 for the performance of required environmental response actions.

Section 3. That the total contract expenditures for these services shall not exceed two hundred thousand & 000/100 dollars (\$200,000.00) for Webster Engineering and eight hundred ten thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$810,000.00) for George Allen Construction Co.

Section 4. That said emergency contracts shall be payable from the Authority's Insurance Fund.

Section 5. That said resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
