

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-176

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SAFETY-KLEEN CORPORATION
FOR THE FURNISHING OF PERIODIC SOLVENT REPLACEMENT
AND PARTS WASH TANK CLEANING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF
ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$98,237.25 - GENERAL FUND) -
BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Safety-Kleen Corporation, located at 777 Big Timber Road, Elgin, Illinois 60123, for the furnishing of periodic solvent replacement and parts wash tank cleaning services for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of ninety-eight thousand two hundred thirty-seven & 25/100 dollars (\$98,237.25) was received on the 10th day of October, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Safety-Kleen Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Safety-Kleen Corporation received October 10, 1990, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Safety-Kleen Corporation for the furnishing of periodic solvent replacement and parts wash tank cleaning services on a periodic basis for a period of one (1) year for the price set forth on said bid.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed ninety-eight thousand two hundred thirty-seven & 25/100 dollars (\$98,237.25).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
