

RESOLUTION NO. 1990-181

AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE BLUE CROSS/BLUE SHIELD OF OHIO TRADITIONAL AND HMO HEALTH OHIO CONTRACTS FOR THE FURNISHING OF HEALTH CARE AND HEALTH CARE INSURANCE ON A MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS FOR A PERIOD OF SIXTY (60) DAYS (EST. \$995,745.10 - GENERAL FUND) HUMAN RESOURCES BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1990-111 extended the Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Ohio contracts for traditional health care and HMO from August 1, 1990 to October 31, 1990;

WHEREAS, an additional two (2) month extension through December 31, 1990 is needed to allow the Authority's negotiating team to evaluate proposals and complete negotiations;

WHEREAS, the contractor has agreed to continue uninterrupted service on a month-to-month basis until such time as new contracts for these services have been entered into; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into extensions of the contracts with Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Ohio for the furnishing of traditional health care and HMO insurance on a month-to-month basis for a period of sixty (60) days, subject to termination by the Authority.


Section 2. That said contracts shall be payable out of the General Fund, Human Resources budget, Line Item 502031, in an estimated amount not to exceed nine hundred ninety-five thousand seven hundred forty-five & 10/100 (\$995,745.10) dollars.

Section 3. That said contracts shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the Contractor to the Contract terms and conditions and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That said resolution shall become effective immediately upon it's adoption.
