

RESOLUTION 1990- 194

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA C&E, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF VARIOUS MOTOROLA MOBILE RADIOS AND TWO (2) DISPATCH CONTROL CONSOLES INCLUDING INSTALLATION FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF (\$525,712.04) WITH AN OPTION FOR TEN (10) ADDITIONAL MOBILE RADIOS FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF (\$22,440.00) RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the bid of Motorola C&E, Inc. located at 12955 Snow Rd., Parma, Ohio for the furnishing of various Motorola radios and two (2) dispatch control consoles including installation was received on the 6th of November, 1990, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of five hundred twenty-five thousand seven hundred twelve & 04/100 dollars (\$525,712.04)

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Motorola C&E, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Motorola C&E, Inc. be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Motorola C&E, Inc. for the furnishing of various Motorola radios and two (2) dispatch control consoles including installation, excluding the option quantity of ten (10) radios.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-90-0078 in the amount of three hundred eleven thousand one hundred forty-eight & 44/100 dollars (\$311,148.44) and OH-03-0054 in the amount of eighty-one thousand four hundred ninety & 20/100 (\$81,490.20) dollars and also payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in the amount of forty thousand three hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$40,350.00) Transit Police Department budget and in the amount of ninety-two thousand seven hundred twenty-three & 40/100 dollars (\$92,723.40) CRT Department Budget.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
