

ESTABLISHING A SPECIFIC POLICY GOVERNING  
THE DISTRIBUTION AND USE OF THE GREATER  
CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY'S  
TRANSFERS

WHEREAS, abuse of transfers by their sale or unauthorized delivery is a continual problem which results in a loss of revenue to the Authority and places an unjustified burden upon those who faithfully adhere to GCRTA's fare policy; and

WHEREAS, efforts to seek the prosecution of those who abuse the use and/or possession of transfers has been frustrated due to the absence of a specific transfer policy; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to establish a policy governing the distribution and unlawful use of transfers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That one transfer shall be made available to each passenger who pays a full fare for express or local service.

Section 2. That the possession and use of the transfer is limited to the passenger who paid the full fare.

Section 3. That the transfer shall remain the property of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

Section 4. That the sale or exchange of a transfer, without proper consideration, is prohibited.

Section 5. That the acceptance, purchase or use of a transfer without the payment of a full fare is prohibited.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
