

RESOLUTION NO. 1990- 222

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL PAPER AND PACKAGING CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF PAPER TOWELS AND TISSUE PRODUCTS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$39,748.50 - GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of National Paper and Packaging Co., located at 1240 East 55th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44103, for the furnishing of paper towels and tissue products was received on the 14th day of September, 1990, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of thirty-nine thousand seven hundred forty-eight & 50/100 dollars (\$39,748.50); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of National Paper and Packaging Co. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of National Paper and Packaging Co. for the furnishing of paper towels and tissue products be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the National Paper and Packaging Co. for the furnishing of paper towels and tissue products for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed thirty-nine thousand seven hundred forty-eight & 50/100 dollars (\$39,748.50).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
