

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-4

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE CALL & POST FOR
ADVERTISEMENT IN A MINORITY CIRCULATION NEWSPAPER FOR
A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (\$37,000.00 - GENERAL FUND) -
PROCUREMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority
requires the ability to advertise in a paper that is aimed at the statewide
minority community;

WHEREAS, the Call & Post is the best qualified to provide the
distribution needed the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Call & Post has offered to provide advertising
services required by O.R.C. 306.43 and UMTA regulations, and which may be
needed from time to tome for the calendar year 1990 at a price not to
exceed thirty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$37,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Call & Post for the
furnishing of advertising in a newspaper aimed at the statewide minority
community for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an
obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to
the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution
1985-87 and all requirements and applicable laws relating to the
contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective
immediately upon its adoption.
