

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-19

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF
TRANSPORTATION FOR THE ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED IN
THE SUBURBS AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO PHYSICIANS
AMBULANCE SERVICE (\$25,000.00 - GENERAL FUND) -
COMMUNITY RESPONSIVE TRANSIT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the General Manager informed the Board of Trustees of
the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority that it was necessary to
implement an emergency program to provide transportation for the elderly
and handicapped in the suburbs; and

WHEREAS, to provide this service it is necessary to enter into an
emergency contract with Physicians Ambulance Service, located at 4349
Monticello Boulevard, South Euclid, Ohio 44121.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That a real and present emergency exists within the
meaning of the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43.

Section 2. That the General Manager is authorized to enter into
a contract with Physicians Ambulance Service, for the provision of
transportation service to the Elderly and Handicapped in accordance with
the Authority's CRT policy.

Section 3. That the total amount of this contract shall not
exceed twenty-five thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$25,000.00).

Section 4. That said emergency contract shall be payable from
the General Fund.

Section 5. That said resolution shall become effective
immediately upon its adoption.
