

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-20

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HOPKINS LIMOUSINE SERVICE, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION FOR THE HANDICAPPED AND ELDERLY FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS WITH TWO SINGLE YEAR RENEWABLE OPTIONS (\$6,145,850.00 - GENERAL FUND) - PARATRANSIT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Hopkins Limousine Service, Inc. located at 13315 Brookpark Road, Brookpark, Ohio 44142, was received on the 21st day of December 1990, involving an expenditure of six million one hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$6,145,850.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Hopkins Limousine Service, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Hopkins Limousine Service, Inc. be and is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Hopkins Limousine Service, Inc. for the furnishing of special transportation for the handicapped and elderly for a period of three (3) years with two (2) single year renewable options.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Paratransit Department Budget) in an estimated amount for the base contract period and option not to exceed six million one hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred fifty & 00/100 dollars (\$6,145,850.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That said resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
