WHEREAS, this 42-coach fleet carries approximately 1,500,000 passengers each year and operates seven different routes under a contract with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:
