## AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COMPUTERLAND FOR THE FURNISHING OF PERSONAL COMPUTERS AND SOFTWARE (\$70,889.67 - GCRTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND) -DATA SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Computerland, located at 7617 Mentor Avenue, Mentor, Ohio, for the furnishing of Personal Computers and Software was received on the 13th day of March, 1991 for a price set forth in said bid of seventy thousand eight hundred eighty-nine & 67/100 dollars (\$70,889.67; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Computerland to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Computerland received on March 13, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Computerland for the furnishing of Personal Computers and Software.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the GCRTA Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed seventy thousand eight hundred eighty-nine & 67/100 dollars (\$70,889.67).

Section 4. That said contracts shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
