

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-61

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO INCREASE THE CONTRACT RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY CONDITION CAUSED BY THE DIESEL FUEL SPILL AT THE HAYDEN GARAGE WITH WEBSTER ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES BY \$60,000.00 (AUTHORITY SELF-INSURANCE FUND).

WHEREAS, on July 24, 1990, Resolution No. 1990-131 ratified an emergency declaration relating to property damage resulting from a diesel fuel leak at the Hayden Garage;

WHEREAS, the Authority has contracted with Webster Engineering Associates in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$200,000.00); and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed to continue the control, containment and elimination of the contaminated product.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager is authorized to increase the contract with Webster Engineering Associates by sixty thousand & 00/100 dollars (60,000.00).

Section 2. That the total contract expenditures for these services shall not exceed two hundred sixty thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$260,000.00).

Section 3. That said amounts shall be payable from the Authority's Self-Insurance Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
