

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-63

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH RICHARD L. BOWEN AND ASSOCIATES FOR ARCHITECT/ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECTS 24D1 AND 24D2 - REHABILITATION OF WEST PARK AND SUPERIOR STATIONS (EST. \$902,015.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104)

WHEREAS, the proposal of Richard L. Bowen and Associates located at 13000 Shaker Boulevard, Cleveland, Ohio 44120 for Architect/Engineering Services for projects 24D1 and 24D2 - Rehabilitation of the Superior and West Park Stations was received on the 13th day of November, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Richard L. Bowen And Associates submitted an offer to provide Architect/Engineering Services for projects 24D1 and 24D2 - Rehabilitation of the West Park and Superior Stations at a cost of nine hundred two thousand fifteen & 00/100 dollars (\$902,015.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems Richard L. Bowen and Associates to be the most qualified provider of the required Architect/Engineering Services and finds the negotiated price to be reasonable, and therefore recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Richard L. Bowen and Associates on November 13, 1990 be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for Architect/Engineering Services for projects 24D1 and 24D2 - Rehabilitation of the West Park and Superior Station at an estimated cost of nine hundred two thousand fifteen & 00/100 dollars (\$902,015.00).

Section 2. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Richard L. Bowen and Associates dated November 13, 1990 as amended by negotiations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0104, Line Item 12.31.02.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
