

RESOLUTION 1991- 64

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BROWNING-FERRIS INDUSTRIES OF OHIO, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF RUBBISH COLLECTION FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS AT AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$415,800.00 (FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Browning-Ferris Industries of Ohio, Inc. located at 8100 Old Granger Rd., Garfield Hts., Ohio 44125, for the furnishing of rubbish collection for a period of two (2) years was received on April 5th, 1991 at an estimated cost not to exceed four hundred fifteen thousand eight hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$415,800.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Browning-Ferris Industries of Ohio, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Browning-Ferris Industries of Ohio, Inc. received on April 5th, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Browning-Ferris Industries of Ohio, Inc. for the furnishing of rubbish collection for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund Facilities Maintenance Department Budget in an amount not to exceed four hundred fifteen thousand eight hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$415,800.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon it's adoption.
