

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-72

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WAKE FOREST GARDEN CENTER
FOR THE FURNISHING OF LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES
FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 17, 1991 THROUGH JANUARY
31, 1993 (EST. \$194,500.00 - GENERAL FUND) -
FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the bid of Wake Forest Garden Center, located at 4583 Lee Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44128, for the furnishing of landscape maintenance services for the period from April 17, 1991 through January 31, 1993 was received on the 11th day of March, 1991, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of one hundred ninety-four thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$194,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Wake Forest Garden Center to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Wake Forest Garden Center for the furnishing of landscape maintenance services for the period from April 17, 1991 through January 31, 1993 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wake Forest Garden Center for the furnishing of landscape maintenance services for the period from April 17, 1991 to January 31, 1993.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount of one hundred ninety-four thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$194,500.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
