

RESOLUTION 1991-75

AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA CORPORATION FOR MOVING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ROOM TO CENTRAL RAIL FACILITY (RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT - \$45,925.00) SUPPORT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interest of GCRTA to move its traffic control room from the State Office Building to the Central Rail Facility located at 6200 Grand Road;

WHEREAS, moving of this equipment requires specialized training and equipment to move the computerized electronic monitoring and communication system;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43(c) provides that competitive bidding is not required when a purchase consists of data processing services as supplied by the original source or its successors;

WHEREAS, Motorola Corporation located at 12955 Snow Road, Parma, Ohio 44130 was the original supplier; and

WHEREAS, Motorola Corporation has offered to move and install all the computerized electronic communication into Central Rail Facility at a cost not to exceed forty-five thousand nine hundred twenty five & 00/100 dollars (\$45,925.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Motorola Corporation.


Section 2. That the contract shall provide for a total expenditure not to exceed forty-five thousand nine hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$45,925.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Improvement Fund, Support Services Department Budget.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the specification and all addenda; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
