RESOLUTION NO. 1991- 81

TO AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NAME OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY IN THE STATE AND FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY PROGRAM WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services is the official agent for the disposal of State and Federal surplus property to political subdivisions in the State of Ohio;

WHEREAS, the State and Federal Surplus Property Program provides the opportunity to political subdivisions to receive State and Federal surplus property at a fraction of its market cost; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.44, permits trustees of a regional transit authority to enter into agreement with the State for exercise of the powers granted by Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.30 to 306.47, inclusive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager hereby requests authority, in the name of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, to participate in State contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, State and Federal Surplus Property Program, has entered into for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment, and certain materials pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Section 125.04.

Section 2. That the General Manager is hereby authorized to agree, in the name of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's participation in the program. Further, the General Manager does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions.

Section 3. That the General Manager is hereby authorized to agree, in the name of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, to directly pay the State for such it receives pursuant to the agreement.

Section 4. That the General Manager may designate those employees that he deems appropriate to purchase State and Federal surplus property.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
