## **RESOLUTION 1991-84**

AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH BTMC CORPORATION, CUMMINS OHIO, INC., THE FLXIBLE CORPORATION AND MUNCIE RECLAMATION AND SUPPLY COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF MOTOR COACH FILTERS IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$21,210.00 (BTMC CORPORATION); \$34,280.00 (CUMMINS OHIO, INC.); \$63,248.30 (THE FLXIBLE CORPORATION) AND \$59,407.00 (MUNCIE RECLAMATION) FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (ESTIMATED \$178,145.30 - GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the bids of BTMC Corporation, 5810 Columbus Pike Road, Delaware, Ohio 43015; Cummins Ohio, Inc. 7585 Northfield Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44146-6186; The Flxible Corporation, 970 Pittsburgh Drive, Delaware, Ohio 43015 and Muncie Reclamation and Supply Company, 3720 South Madison, Muncie, Indiana 47302 for the furnishing of motor coach filters for a one (1) year period in response to Invitation for Bid No. 91015 were received on the 15th day of May, 1991, for the prices set forth in said bids, involving an estimated expenditure of one hundred seventy-eight thousand one hundred forty-five & 30/100 dollars (\$178,145.30);

WHEREAS, this procurement is divisible;

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of BTMC Corporation for items numbered 1 and 9 of this Invitation For Bid to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder with regard to said items and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees:

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Cummins Ohio, Inc. for item number 5 of this Invitation For Bid to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder with regard to said items and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of The Flxible Corporation for items numbered 2, 7, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 of this Invitation for Bid to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder with regard to said items and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply Company for items number 3, 4, 6, 8 and 11 of this Invitation For Bid to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder with regard to said items and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland REgional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of BTMC Corporation for items numbered 1 and 9 of the Invitation For Bid No. 91015 advertised April 16, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the bid of Cummins Ohio, Inc. for item number 5 of the Invitation For Bid No. 91015 advertised April 16, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 3. That the bid of The Flxible Corporation for items numbered 2, 7, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 of the Invitation For Bid No. 91015 advertised April 16, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 4. That the bid of Muncie Reclamation and Supply Company for items numbered 3, 4, 6, 8, and 11 of the Invitation For Bid No. 91015 advertised April 16, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 5. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into requirements contracts with BTMC Corporation, Cummins Ohio, Inc., The Flxible Corporation and Muncie Reclamation and Supply Company for the furnishing of motor coach filters for one (1) year commencing on or about May 31, 1991.

Section 6. That said contracts shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) \$21,210.00 (BTMC Corporation); \$34,280.00 (Cummins Ohio, Inc.) \$63,248.30; and (The Flxible Corporation) \$59,407.00 (Muncie Reclamation) for a total expenditure not to exceed one hundred seventy-eight thousand one hundred forty-five & 30/100 dollars (\$178,145.30).

Section 7. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 8. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
