AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TUBELITE COMPANY, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF VINYL SHEETING/TAPE (PVC FILM) AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (NOT TO EXCEED \$118,920.50 - GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Tubelite Company, Inc., located a 1224 Refugee Lane, Columbus, Ohio 43207-1224, or the furnishing of vinyl sheeting/tape, was received on the 8th day of May, 1991 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure not exceed one hundred eighteen thousand nine hundred twenty & 50/100 dollars (\$118,920.50); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Tubelite Company, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Tubelite Company, Inc. be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a requirements contract with Tubelite Company, Inc. for the furnishing of vinyl sheet/tape (PVC film) as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount not to exceed one hundred eighteen thousand nine hundred twenty & 50/100 dollars (\$118,920.50).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
