AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH UNIVERSAL OIL, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF ENGINE OIL FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS (EST. \$173,016.00 - GENERAL FUND) INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the bid of Universal Oil, Inc., located at 265 Jefferson Ave., Cleveland, Ohio 44113, for the furnishing of engine oil was received on the 8th of May, 1991 for the price set forth in said bid involving an estimated expenditure of one hundred seventy-three thousand sixteen  $\overline{\&}$  00/100 dollars (\$173,016.00); and

That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
