

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-118

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GRAHAM CHEVROLET FOR THE FURNISHING OF SIX (6) TRANSIT POLICE VEHICLES (\$96,665.04 - RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND) TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Graham Chevrolet, located at 1515 West Fourth Street, Mansfield, Ohio 44916 for the furnishing of six (6) transit police vehicles was received on the 5th day of June for the price set forth in said bid involving an expenditure of ninety-six thousand six hundred sixty-five and 04/100 dollars (\$96,665.04); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Graham Chevrolet to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Graham Chevrolet and the same is hereby authorized as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Graham Chevrolet for the furnishing of six (6) transit police vehicles.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund in an amount of ninety-six thousand six hundred sixty-five and 04/100 dollars (\$96,645.04).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
