

RESOLUTION NO. 1991- 123

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 89010 WITH PETER MULLER-MUNK ASSOCIATES FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR SAFETY SIGNAGE AND GRAPHICS DESIGN (PROJECT 10) \$149,600.00 - CAPITAL GRANTS: OH-03-0054, \$50,100.00; OH-90-0068, \$33,000.00; OH-03-0104, \$30,000.00; \$36,500.00 RTA CAPITAL FUND (\$88,980.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 59.5% OF THE TOTAL PROJECT COST).

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1989-104 adopted July 18, 1989 authorized a contract with Peter Muller-Munk Associates, a Division of Wilbur Smith and Associates, located at 501 Martindale Street, Pittsburgh, PA. 15212, for the design of standard safety signage and graphics for the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority facilities at a price of one hundred twenty-eight thousand four hundred & 00/100 (\$128,400.00) dollars; and

WHEREAS, additional safety signage and graphics and other technical coordinations relating to current and future projects require these services in order to meet the needs of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, it is mutually agreeable to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority and to Peter Muller-Munk Associates to increase the contract scope to incorporate the added work; and

WHEREAS, an estimated price adjustment of one hundred forty-nine thousand six hundred & 00/100 (\$149,600.00) dollars is required to complete the added work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Peter Muller-Munk Associates at an estimated price adjustment of one hundred forty-nine thousand six hundred & 00/100 (\$149,600.00) and a revised total estimated contract amount of two hundred seventy-eight thousand & 00/100 (\$278,000.00) dollars.

Section 2. That said contract amendment shall be payable out of Capital Grants OH-03-0054, OH-90-0068, and OH-03-0104.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.
