RESOLUTION NO. 1991–126

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ESTABLISH A CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT REDUCED FARE ZONE.

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Central Business District Reduced Fare Zone will allow the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (RTA) to increase the efficiency of its transit operations by enabling the RTA to offer more service at a reduced cost;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the General Manager is hereby authorized to establish the Reduced Fare Zone in the Central Business District defined in Exhibit A., which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if fully rewritten herein.


- **Section 2**: That Resolution No. 1991-24, adopted January 22, 1991, be and is hereby amended as follows:
 - A. In section 2, delete "DOWNTOWN LOOP SERVICE FARES" and replace it with "CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT REDUCED FARE ZONE FARES".
 - B. In section 2, delete "(Transfers will be issued from Downtown Loop with payment of full Local or Express Fare)" and replace it with "(Local or Express transfers will be issued from the Central Business District Reduced Fare Zone with payment of full Local or Express Fare. A Reduced Fare Zone transfer shall be issued free for travel wholly within the Central Business District Reduced Fare Zone)".
- **Section 3**: That all other provisions of Resolution No. 1991-24, as amended shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
