

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GEORGE ALLEN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE MODIFICATION OF THE CBM PAINT SHOP - SPRAY PAINT BOOTHS, PROJECT 2.95 (\$353,746.00: RTA CAPITAL FUND \$100,000, CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-0019 \$253,746.00 - \$202,996.80 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS APPROXIMATELY 57% OF THE TOTAL COST)

WHEREAS, the bid of George Allen Construction Company, Inc. located at P.O. Box 81462, Cleveland, Ohio 44181 for the modification of the CBM Paint Shop - Spray Paint Booths was received on the 1st day of July, 1991 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of three hundred fifty-three thousand seven hundred and forty-six & 00/100 (\$353,746.00) dollars; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of George Allen Construction Company, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of George Allen Construction Company, Inc. for the modification of the CBM Paint Shop - Spray Paint Booth be and the same is hereby authorized as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with George Allen Construction Company, Inc. for the modification of the CBM Paint Shop - Spray Paint Booth.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Grant OH-90-0019 in the amount of two hundred fifty-three thousand seven hundred and forty-six dollars & 00/100 dollars (\$253,746.00) and the RTA Capital Fund in the amount of one hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$100,000).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
