

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DEARBORN FABRICATING & ENGINEERING CORPORATION OF INDIANA FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE 7-1/2 TON OVERHEAD CRANE FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$34,908.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0054 (80% FEDERAL FUNDS - \$27,926.40).**

WHEREAS, the bid of Dearborn Fabricating & Engineering Corporation of Indiana, located at 1131 East 5th Street, Mishawaka, Indiana 46544, for the furnishing of one 7-1/2 ton crane was received on the 6th of August, 1991 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of thirty-four thousand nine hundred eight & 00/100 dollars (\$34,908.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Dearborn Fabricating & Engineering Corporation of Indiana to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Dearborn Fabricating & Engineering Corporation of Indiana be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

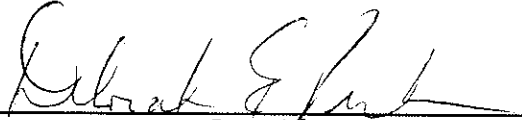
Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Dearborn Fabricating & Engineering Corporation of Indiana for the furnishing of one 7-1/2 ton overhead crane.

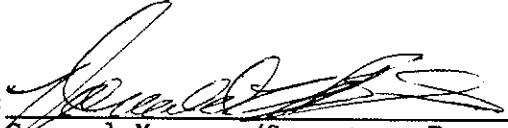
Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-03-0054 for a total of thirty-four thousand nine hundred eight & 00/100 dollars (\$34,908.00), eighty percent (80%) of which twenty-seven thousand nine hundred twenty-six & 40/100 (\$27,926.40) shall be federal funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
