

RESOLUTION 1991- 176

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HERN OLDS/GMC FOR
THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1) 3/4 TON CARGO VAN
(\$16,039.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND) PARATRANSIT
DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the bid of Hern Olds/GMC located at 424 Broadway, Bedford, Ohio, for the furnishing of one (1) 3/4 ton cargo van was received on August 19, 1991 for a price set forth in said bid of sixteen thousand thirty-nine dollars & 00/100 dollars (\$16,039.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Hern Oldsmobile/GMC to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Hern Olds/GMC received on August 19, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Hern Olds/GMC for the furnishing of one (1) 3/4 ton cargo van.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in an amount not to exceed sixteen thousand thirty-nine & 00/100 dollars (\$16,039.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That his resolution shall become effective immediately upon it's adoption.
