RESOLUTION 1991- 197

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA (C&E) INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF SEVENTY-TWO (72) PORTABLE RADIOS AND TWENTY-ONE (21) CHARGERS AT A PRICE OF \$166,750.80: CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0113 (127,624.00) AND CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X149 (\$39,126.80), OF WHICH \$127,019.44 IS FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 76.2% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the only source of supply for these system compatible radios is Motorola; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 306.43(B) provides that competitive bidding is not required when such purchase consists of supplies or replacement or supplemental parts for a products or equipment owned or leased by the regional transit authority and the only source of supply for such supplies or parts is limited to a single supplier;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Motorola (C&E) Inc. for the purchase of seventy-two (72) portable radios and twenty-one chargers at a price of one hundred sixty-six thousand seven hundred fifty & 80/100 dollars (\$166,750.80).

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable as follows: one hundred twenty-seven thousand six hundred twenty-four & 00/100 dollars (\$127,624.00) from Capital Grant OH-03-0113, of which 75% or \$95,718.00 shall be Federal Funds; thirty-nine thousand one hundred twenty-six & 80/100 dollars (\$39,126.80) or 23.5% from Capital Grant OH-90-X149, of which 80% or \$31,301.44 shall be Federal Funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
