

RESOLUTION 1991-198

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MARSHALL FORD EAST
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO (2) SUPERVISORY VANS
(\$32,493.20 - RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND)
TECHNICAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the bid of Marshall Ford East located at 6200 Mayfield Rd., Mayfield Heights, Ohio for the furnishing of two (2) supervisory vehicles was received on August 19, 1991 for a price set forth in said bid of thirty-two thousand four hundred ninety-three & 20/100 dollars (\$32,493.20); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Marshall Ford East to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Marshall Ford East received on August 19, 1991 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Marshall Ford East for the furnishing of two (2) supervisory vehicles.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund in an amount of thirty-two thousand, four hundred ninety-three & 20/100 dollars (\$32,493.20).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
