

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-201

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PRECISION DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE MADISON/CORDOVA & E.105TH ST./DUPONT BUS LOOPS, PROJECTS 18A & B (\$427,000.00 - \$362,950.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS APPROXIMATELY 85% OF THE TOTAL COST) CAPITAL GRANT OH-23-9004

WHEREAS, the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc., located at 249 State Route 303, Streetsboro, Ohio 44241 for the rehabilitation of the Madison/Cordova & East 105th Street/Dupont Bus Loops, Project 18A & B was received on the 9th day of October, 1991 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of four hundred twenty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$427,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc. for the rehabilitation of Madison/Cordova & East 105th Street/Dupont Bus Loops be and the same is hereby authorized as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Precision Design & Construction, Inc. for the rehabilitation of the Madison/Cordova & East 105th Street/Dupont Bus Loops.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Grant in the amount of four hundred twenty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$427,000.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
