

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-206

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO INCREASE THE CONTRACT WITH DELTA RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR PROJECT 23E1 - THE REHABILITATION OF RED LINE TRACK CUT TO WEST 117TH STREET FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$695,000.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0097 (\$521,250.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority awarded a contract to Delta Railroad Construction, Inc., located at 2648 West Prospect Road, Ashtabula, Ohio 44004 for the for the rehabilitation of Red Line Track CUT to West 117th Street at a price of four million three hundred forty-nine thousand four hundred five & 00/100 (\$4,349,405.00) dollars, and

WHEREAS, the contract allows for modification to the quantity of running rail renewal at the unit price bid.

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best interest of the Authority to install additional track from West 117th to West 150th Street at the unit price in the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Delta Railroad Construction, Inc., for additional work on the rehabilitation of the red line track at an amount not to exceed six hundred ninety-five thousand & 00/100 (\$695,000.00 dollars and a total contract amount of five million forty-four thousand four hundred five & 00/100 (\$5,044,405.00) dollars.

Section 2. That this amendment shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-03-0097, Line Item 12.24.03.

Section 3. That all terms and conditions of the contract shall remain the same.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
