

RESOLUTION NO. 1991- 212

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH JIMMY DIESEL, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF ENGINE BLOCK REPAIR FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$237,000.00 GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Jimmy Diesel, Inc. located at 550 South East Avenue, La Grange, Illinois 60525-6898 for the furnishing of engine block repair was received on the 14th day of October, 1991, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of two hundred thirty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$237,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Jimmy Diesel, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Jimmy Diesel, Inc. for the furnishing of engine block repair be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jimmy Diesel, Inc. for the furnishing of engine block repair for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount of two hundred thirty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$237,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
