

RESOLUTION 1991-221

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WELLS FARGO ALARM SERVICES FOR THE FURNISHING AND INSTALLATION OF A SECURITY PROTECTION SYSTEM FOR EIGHTEEN (18) RED LINE BOOTHS AND ELEVEN (11) ADDITIONAL GCRTA LOCATIONS FOR A TOTAL PRICE OF \$43,980.00 - (RTA CAPITAL FUND) TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the bid of Wells Fargo Alarm Services located at 42 S. Frank Blvd., Akron, Ohio for the furnishing and installation of a security protection system for eighteen (18) red line booths and eleven (11) additional GCRTA locations was received on the 7th of November, 1991, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of forty-three thousand nine hundred eighty & 00/100 dollars.

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Wells Fargo Alarm Services to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Wells Fargo Alarm Services be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wells Fargo Alarm Services for the furnishing and installation of security protection system for eighteen (18) red line booths and eleven (11) additional GCRTA locations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund (Transit Police Department Budget) for a total price of forty-three thousand nine hundred eighty & 00/100 dollars (\$43,980.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
