

RESOLUTION 1991-225

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH UNION EYE CARE CENTER, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF VISION CARE BENEFITS COVERAGE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1, 1992 (EST. \$216,324.00, GENERAL FUND - FRINGE BENEFITS ACCOUNT)

WHEREAS, the proposal of Union Eye Care Center, Inc., located at 20525 Center Ridge Road, Rocky River, Ohio 44116 to provide vision care benefits for a period of three (3) years, was received on November 1, 1991.

WHEREAS, Union Eye Care Center, Inc., has offered an estimated price of two hundred sixteen thousand three hundred twenty-four dollars (\$216,324.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer of Union Eye Care Center, Inc., to be the most advantageous and finds the price to be reasonable, and, therefore, recommends the same for acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Union Eye Care Center, Inc., be and it is hereby accepted as the most advantageous offer to provide the Authority's vision care benefits for a period of three (3) years.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Union Eye Care Center, Inc., for the furnishing of vision care benefits for a period of three (3) years, commencing January 1, 1992 and ending December 31, 1994.

Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal dated November 1, 1991, and subsequent pricing negotiations.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount of two hundred sixteen thousand three hundred twenty-four dollars (\$216,324.00).

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

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Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
