

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-227

AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF DUES TO THE NORTHEAST OHIO
AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92
(\$45,000.00 - GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) conducts comprehensive transportation planning and functions as the metropolitan planning organization for the region in accordance with Federal transportation regulations; and

WHEREAS, new Federal transportation policy is likely to increase the flexibility of using highway funds for transit projects with the metropolitan planning organizations in urban areas playing a key role in making decisions on such funding matters; and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency has revised its governance structure and the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has gained a position on the NOACA Policy Board as a result; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is obligated to pay annual dues as a condition of having a position on the NOACA Policy Board; and

WHEREAS, this dues payment along with the dues from other participating governmental units are used to help fund NOACA's activities and to match Federal and State grants used for transportation planning activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, that:

Section 1. The General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay to NOACA the Authority's FY 1991-92 dues in the amount of \$45,000.00.

Section 2. The payment of the Authority's FY 1991-92 dues to NOACA will be made in the Authority's fiscal year 1991 from the the General Fund in the amount of \$45,000.00 (Executive Department budget, Line Item 509.010 - Miscellaneous Expenses).

Section 3. This Resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
