

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MIDWEST BUS REBUILDERS CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF REPAIRS TO THE FLOOR ASSEMBLIES ON EIGHTEEN (18) 8300 FLEET FLXIBLE METRO COACHES (EST. \$171,198.00 - RTA CAPITAL FUND) - BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the bid of Midwest Bus Rebuilders Corporation, located at 1940 West Stewart Street, Owosso, Michigan 48867, for the furnishing of repairs to eighteen (18) floor assemblies on the 8300 fleet Flxible Metro coaches was received on the 9th of December 1991, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of one hundred seventy-one thousand one hundred ninety-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$171,198.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Midwest Bus Rebuilders Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Midwest Bus Rebuilders Corporation be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manger of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Midwest Bus Rebuilders Corporation for the furnishing of repairs to eighteen (18) floor assemblies on the 8300 fleet Flxible Metro coaches

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed one hundred seventy-one thousand one hundred ninety-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$171,198.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
