

RESOLUTION NO. 1991- 240

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SAFETY KLEEN CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF PERIODIC SOLVENT REPLACEMENT AND PARTS CLEANING TANK SERVICE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$108,636.75 - GENERAL FUND) - BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Safety Kleen Corporation, located at 717 Big Timber Road, Elgin, Illinois 60118, for the furnishing of periodic solvent replacement and parts cleaning tank service was received on the 9th day of December 1991, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of one hundred eight thousand six hundred thirty-six & 75/100 (\$108,636.75) dollars; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Safety Kleen Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Safety Kleen Corporation be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Safety Kleen Corporation for the furnishing of periodic solvent replacement and parts cleaning tank service for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in a estimated amount not to exceed one hundred eight thousand six hundred thirty-six & 75/100 dollars (\$108,636.75).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
