

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COMPUTERLAND/NEWTON DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF COMPUTER HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$85,508.09) - RTA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the bid of Computerland/Newton Development Corporation, located at 6300 Rockside Road, Independence, Ohio 44131, for the furnishing of Items 4, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 32, 37, 40, 41, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 56, and 60 of IFB No. 91090, Computer Hardware and Software for a Period of One (1) Year, was received on the 9th day of December 1991 for an estimated price not to exceed eighty-five thousand five hundred eight & 09/100 dollars (\$85,508.09); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Computerland/Newton Development Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for said items and recommends acceptance thereof for said items by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Computerland/Newton Development Corporation received on December 9, 1991, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

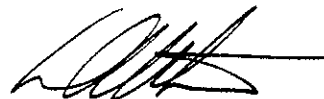
Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Computerland/Newton Development Corporation for the furnishing of Items 4, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 32, 37, 40, 41, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 56, and 60 of IFB No. 91090, Computer Hardware and Software for a Period of One (1) Year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed eighty-five thousand five hundred eight & 09/100 dollars (\$85,508.09).

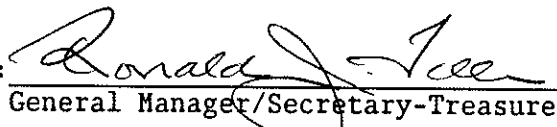
Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future contract years and upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
