

RESOLUTION NO. 1991-255

**AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF THE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT
WITH MOTOROLA C&E INC. FOR MAINTENANCE SERVICES ON
MOTOROLA COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR A PERIOD OF
TWO (2) YEARS COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1992 THROUGH
DECEMBER 31, 1993 (\$75,360.00 - GENERAL FUND) BUS
EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Traffic Communications System of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority consists of computer communications equipment purchased from Motorola Communications and Electronics Inc., located at 1309 E. Algonquin Road, Schaumburg, IL 70196-1080, over a period of time; and

WHEREAS, Motorola Communications and Electronic, Inc. owns the patents, copyrights and license for the software used by the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's Communications System and is, therefore, a sole source provider in accordance with O.R.C. 306.43(b); and

WHEREAS, Motorola Communications and Electronics Inc. located 12955 Snow Rd. Cleveland, Ohio 44130 is the local provider of this maintenance service; and

WHEREAS, this equipment is necessary for the proper and safe operation of bus and rail service and must be maintained seven (7) days a week, twenty-four (24) hours per day; and

WHEREAS, to insure continuity of service it is in the best interest of the Authority to enter into a two (2) year agreement for said service;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a two (2) year agreement for communication equipment maintenance services for the period January 1, 1992 through December 31, 1993 in the amount of seventy-five thousand three hundred sixty & 00/100 dollars (\$75,360.00) payable from the General Fund Bus Equipment Department Budget.

Section 2. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
